

The Spirit of Relay Team Award

Description:

The Spirit of Relay - Team Award recognises a Relay For Life team that exemplifies the “True Spirit of Relay.” Teams who are nominated for this award have fully engaged all of its team members through fundraising, survivor and caregiver engagement, and knowledge of their organisation’s mission in the fight against cancer.

Qualifications:

Spirit of Relay Team Award winner must prove a commitment to excellence in each of the key development areas of Relay For Life. All of their events must follow all the Global Relay For Life Standards.

- **Leadership Development** – Have a strong team captain and co-captain that help to organise the team.
- **Team Development** – Host pre-event and day of event team activities and fundraisers, have a minimum of 10 members, and engage in ongoing communication before and after the event.
- **Survivor and Caregiver Development** – The team must recruit and engage survivors and caregivers into the team’s activities.
- **Event Development** – Have an engaging campsite theme or activities that demonstrate your team’s spirit and passion.
- **Fundraising Development** – Each team member must raise money personally.
- **Mission Development** – Demonstrates an understanding of the mission of their organisation through their fundraising team activities.



Application Process

Nominations for this award can be submitted by volunteers or staff partners who interacted with a qualifying team at a Relay For Life event (youth, college, corporate, and/or community Relay.)
