What if you were diagnosed with cancer and felt lost and without hope? What if your loved ones could not come to terms with your diagnosis or you needed assistance to help you cope with the side effects of treatment?



 CANSA's service ensures you do not face a diagnosis alone and provides hope. You and your loved ones receive emotional and practical support so that you can tackle the disease together.


What if you did not have access to information to educate you about the symptoms of cancer or to cancer screening to prevent a late diagnosis?



 CANSA's service teaches you about the symptoms of cancer and makes affordable cancer screening available, enabling early detection, potentially saving your life.

What if you did not know that you could lower your cancer risk?



 CANSA's service teaches you how to take care of yourself by helping you to lower your personal cancer risk.



R550 will help sponsor free telephonic counselling, available in 7 languages



R350 will enable an individual / group counselling session



R150 will help us run a support group with refreshments for patients in their community



R100 will enable us to produce one CANSA CancerCare Coping Kit Booklet to help a patient and loved ones cope with a cancer diagnosis



R300 can keep our CANSA Help Desk operational for 30 minutes (this includes toll free calls, emails, and multilingual WhatsApp support)



R650 will enable us to provide accommodation, food and transport to one cancer patient, per day, staying at our Care Homes, who live far away from treatment centres*

* Patient income is taken into consideration



R300 will enable us to put together a CANSA Care Pack for an adult.



R220 allows us to provide a tin of meal replacement for a child / teen or adult at much more affordable rates



R4 500 will enable the purchase of a port / broadac to make cancer treatment for a child less traumatic



R120 can help volunteers knit / crochet two Knitted knockers for women who cannot afford breast prosthesis.



R1 000 will enable us to transform hair donations received into one wig



R150 enables CANSA to purchase a pack of adult diapers to allow us to provide at much more affordable rates



R300 will enable the purchase of a two week supply of sanitary towels / diapers to a cervical cancer patient



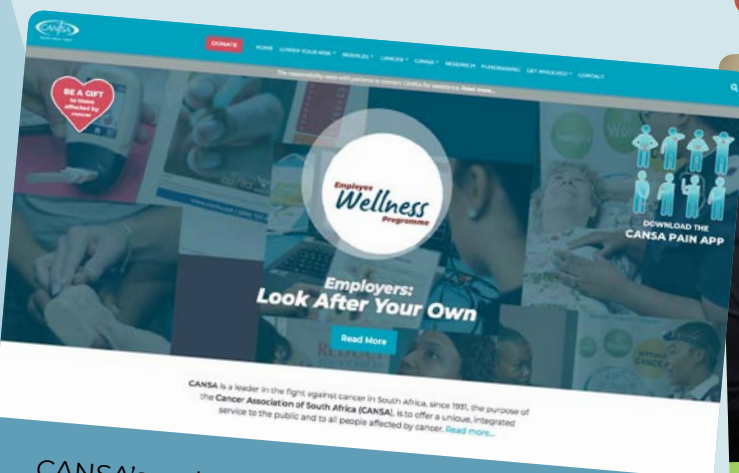
R380 will help fund consumables & cytology for one Pap smear test, screening for cervical cancer and a clinical breast examination to ladies from disadvantaged communities



R500 will enable training of one patient care volunteer



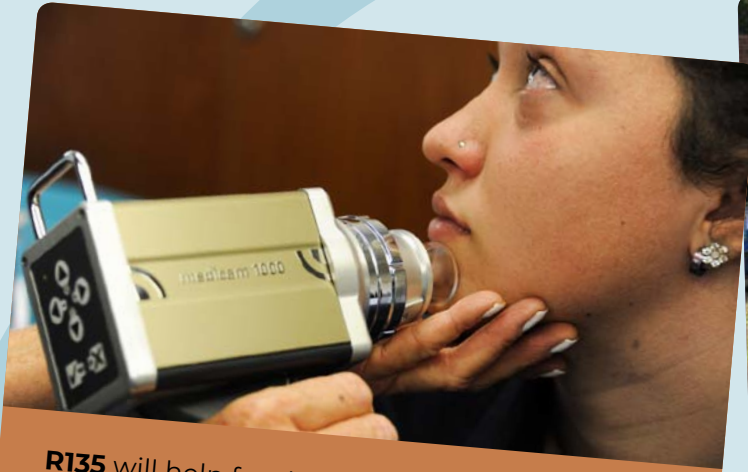
R90 will help fund a Clinical Breast Examination to ladies from disadvantaged communities (routine physical exam - touch / visual - of breasts to detect lumps / abnormalities)



CANSA's website (with average 40K pages viewed per month) provides crucial information regarding cancer, coping with diagnosis, side effects of treatment and links to online support groups and resources, CANSA's care and support services, and tips to lower cancer risk aligned with CANSA research / advocacy



R180 will help pay for a Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) blood test screening for prostate cancer in men from disadvantaged communities



R135 will help fund one FotoFinder Mole Analysis, screening for skin cancer, for one person from disadvantaged communities



R5 000 will cover running costs for one day, of our Mobile Health Clinic visiting remote areas to offer screening. Or donate **R850** to fill up the tank with fuel.



R500 will enable us to print 100 educational posters to be placed in local schools, clinics, hospitals & community centres



R500 will enable us to produce 300 educational pamphlets to make the public aware of screening available, cancer symptoms and how to reduce cancer risk



R500 will enable CANSA to support researchers conducting research at local tertiary institutions to help reduce cancer risk. Findings from research also help us to provide accurate information regarding reduction of personal cancer risk to the public...
